- c. <u>Church Website</u> Tim shared recent statistics on site visits to our Church and noted that he would either remove the 'feedback form' or create a Captcha to prevent negative counts by spam bots; which have evidently caused fictitious hit counts, a total of 2,639, during the month of January. No further action taken.
- d. <u>Engage & Equip</u> This workshop attended by Tim and Pastor Toensing in January sparked interest in connection with community leaders in the surrounding area in hopes we may find a way to engage and make a worthy connection to those outside of our congregation in the surrounding area. Th continuation of building upon some ideas presented at the workshop will likely be an ongoing topic of interest for the Committee. No further action taken.
- e. <u>Promotional Ads</u> Discussion was held a possible placing of another ad in, at or before the Lenten Season in connection with Easter. Members were to consider and/or bring back ideas for the Crete newspaper. No further action taken.
- f. <u>District Mailing List</u> The committee asked Tim to obtain an updated "new movers" mailing list from the District LCMS in which to send invitation postcards. Tim will research and obtain a price for mailing size, printing and mailing costs. Potential value seen in using a printing/mailing service also. No further action taken.
- g. <u>"Continued Prayer for St. John, it's members and other local LCMS congregations</u> in our district was reminded for the group. In further action, Pastor Toensing provided the committee members a copy of each church name, location and their pastors in our south Lincoln circuit to use in times of prayer for those congregations.

Options were whittled down to Saturday, March 30th and Saturday, April 6th.
